## Personal Chromebook Policy



With the approval of the school's administration, students may "opt-out" of the school's 1:1 take-home program if they choose to bring to school, every day, a personal Chromebook. Students may be required to submit their device to the IT department for software and/or certificate installation in order to ensure the safety and security of the school's network and students.

The district is not responsible for damage, loss, theft, troubleshooting, or any cost incurred in using the device.
